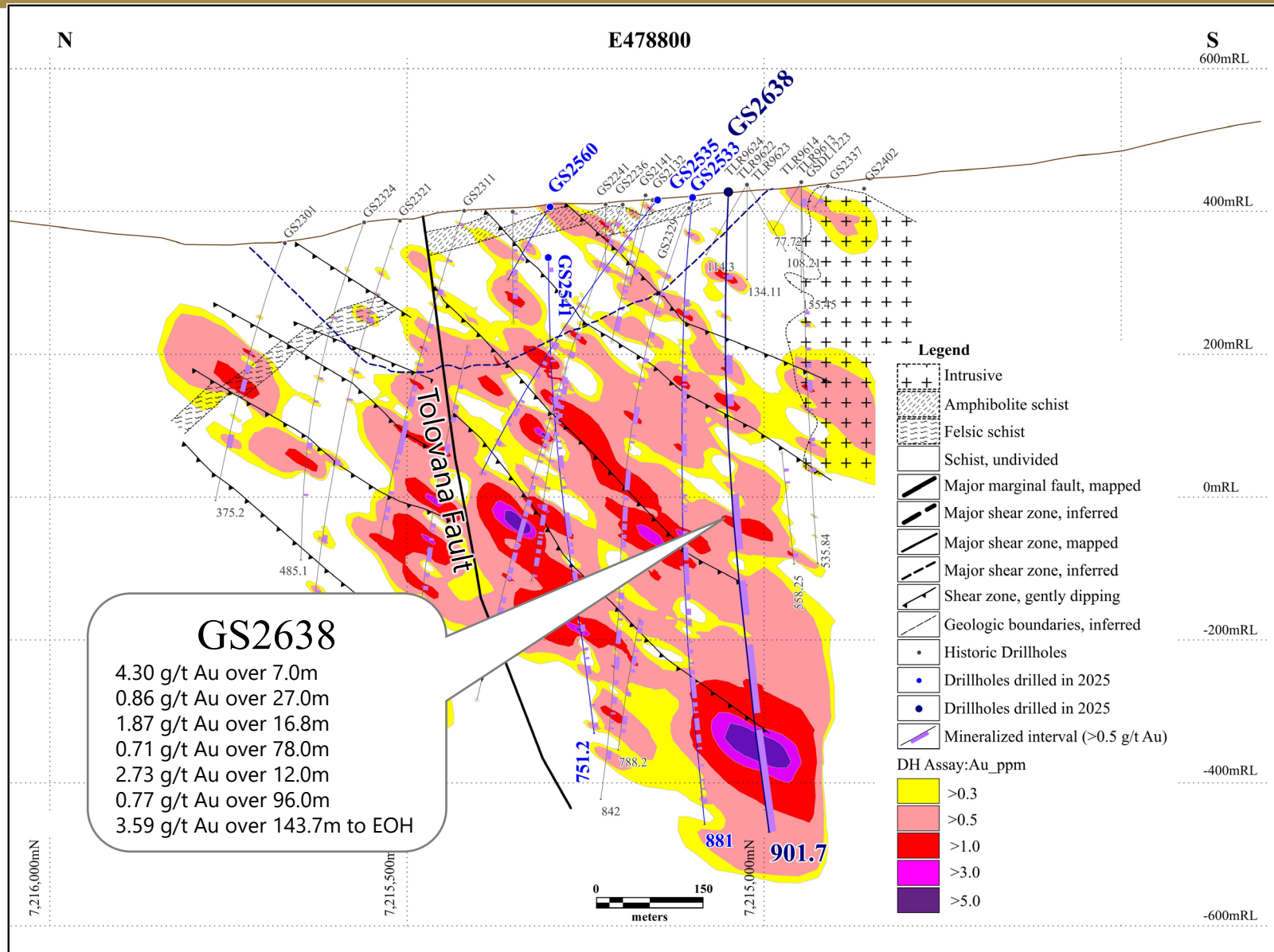

- 11.59 g/t Au over 1.9m from 119.0–120.9 m, associated with brecciated quartz-arsenopyrite-pyrite veins in a shear zone.
- 7.92 g/t Au over 3.0m from 464.0–467.0 m, associated with quartz-arsenopyrite-pyrite veins.
- 3.59 g/t Au over 143.7m from 759.9m.
- 141.3 g/t Au over 3.0m from 779.0–782.0 m, associated with quartz-arsenopyrite-pyrite veins containing visible gold and green clay.
- Mineralization remains open and widening (expanding) at depth and may indicate a deep-rooted mineralized source.
